



Sixth Grade Scope and Sequence

Each elementary year consists of 36 weeks of possible teaching:

- 9 core units in chronological order (two-week units)
- 6 inductive Bible study units (two-week units)
- 3 holiday units (Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter; one-week units)
- 3 bonus units that cover general topics such as the church (one-week units)
